### CHCSS00114 ENTRY INTO CARE ROLES SKILL SET



**Are you seeking to enter the workforce, looking for a career change or just wanting to develop new skills? This course will rapidly upskill you to work in entry level care and support roles in the aged care and disability support sectors even if you've never had any work experience. These sectors have been identified as growth areas and will continue to need skilled workers now and into the future.**

This skill set has been designed to meet an immediate and growing industry need as a result of COVID-19. It provides individuals with knowledge and skills of introductory care practices to support fully qualified carers within an aged care or disability support environment. Candidates will be equipped to undertake tasks such as making beds, providing assistance to maintain a clean environment and communicating with carers as part of the support service.

#### Pathways from the qualification

Certificate III in Individual Support and other qualifications that allow selection of the units in this skill set

#### Career Opportunities in the Industry

This qualification addresses work primarily in residential facilities under direct or regular supervision within clearly defined organisation guidelines and service plans.

You will be a support worker required to work closely with fully qualified carers and report to service managers.



#### Entry requirements

- Completion of Australian Secondary (Year 12) education or equivalent;
- Proficiency in English – Minimum IELTS overall band score of 5.5 or as assessed by HIC as having the proficiency to meet the course requirements;
- Above 18 years of age.

#### Course Duration & Location

Students can expect to undertake 20 hours of blended learning (face-to-face and/or online) each week to successfully complete this course in 8 weeks of full-time study with at least 3 days interaction per week.

This program is delivered online and /or in a classroom-based environment with access to an aged care simulation lab for practical components of the course, whichever is possible. In addition, students will also be required to undertake a practical placement in a workplace environment under supervision to ensure the student can perform the work as expressed in each unit of competency. It is expected that students make personal arrangements for this to happen. Each unit is delivered and assessed as a standalone unit. This program also contains an e-learning component to consolidate teaching and learning.
